In addition to her role as chair of the Board of Transparency International, Conference keynote speaker Dr. Huguette Labelle is also a member of various other boards and bodies, including the Board of the UN Global Compact, the Group of External Advisors on the World Bank Governance and Anti-corruption Strategy, the Advisory Group to the Asian Development Bank on Climate Change and Sustainable Development, the Executive Board of the Africa Capacity Building Foundation, the Global Centre for Pluralism, and the Advisory Council of the Order of Ontario. She is also Vice Chair of the Senior Advisory Board of the International Anti-Corruption Academy and provides advisory services to various national and

international organizations.

Dr. Labelle served for 19 years as Deputy Minister of different Canadian Government departments and is a former Chancellor of the University of Ottawa.
